

Maidzuara holds a Bachelor of Laws degree from the London School of Economics and Political Science, University of London, and was called to the degree of an Utter Barrister by the Honourable Society of Gray's Inn, England, in 1989. She was admitted as an Advocate and Solicitor of the High Court of Malaya in July 1990 after which she practised as a litigator with reputable firms in Kuala Lumpur, gaining extensive experience in corporate, commercial and civil disputes and thus far accumulating many reported cases to her credit. Maidzuara joined the Firm as a partner in January 2008, and joined forces with Darryl Goon in the Dispute Resolution Practice Group. Her current focus is on medical negligence cases, in relation to which she has appeared before the Court of Appeal and the Federal Court on numerous occasions. From time to time, she lectures on medico-legal issues at the Penang Medical College. Maidzuara is a member of the Advocacy Training Committee of the Malaysian Bar Council and is also the Vice-Chair of the Legal Development and Training Committee of the Inter-Pacific Bar Association.
