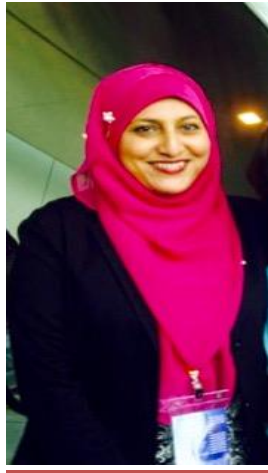


SHAREENA BIBI MOHD ARIF
